

## Beta 2-Stroke Exhaust Collar Part# AB-21410

Fits: 2013+ 250/300 RR/XTrainer 2-strokes

## Smaller Opening Toward Headpipe Inner Edge Larger Opening Toward Rear Silencer





## **Installation Instructions:**

Note: Beta 2-T exhaust collars fit very tightly to ensure as leakfree a fitment as possible. Performing initial pipe-prep steps prevents o-ring damage & ensures a tight fitment. Clean & dry the bike & exhaust connection areas before beginning.

- 1. Remove the seat, right side mid-panel, & the lower side panel mount screw to allow access to the rear silencer mount screws.
- 2. Remove both the rear silencer & headpipe from the bike.
- 3. The aerospace grade inner o-rings fit tightly & expand with heat to form a tight seal, do not damage these high-temp o-rings.
- 4. Use a file or bell grinder to fully radius (round out) & smooth the leading edges of the silencer & pipe's adjoining connection ends to help the collar's inner o-rings slip over them.
- 5. Wipe off any debris around these edges for a clean fitment.
- Note: It's optional to add a small ring of Permatex Ultra Copper 101B red silicone seal on the inside tube of the silencer end that connects over the headpipe, to help seal & strengthen the joint.
- 7. Coat both inner o-rings of the collar with high-temp grease prior to pipe insertion to ease install & prevent o-ring damage.
- 8. Locate the collar's larger opening & insert it onto the rear silencer until it fully seats into the collar's inner edge.
- 9. Loosely remount the headpipe back onto the engine & frame so that its position can be adjusted during collar insertion.
- 10. Slide the silencer with collar over the headpipe until the rear silencer mount tabs are aligned with the rear subframe mounts holes.
- 11. Loosely mount the rear silencer in place, then reinstall the headpipe at the engine, & tighten both headpipe frame fasteners.
- 12. Tighten the headpipe & rear silencer mount screws securely.
- 13. Reinstall rear side panel mount screws, & reinstall the seat.
