

Beta Airbox Cover Fastener Kit

Part# AB-22002

Fits: All Beta's with quick-release airbox covers





Installation Instructions:

Tools Needed: Power drill, 1/8" & 7/32" drill-bits, vise-grip pliers or a benchvise, exacto knife, heat source, 3mm allen wrench.

- 1. Using a 1/8" drill bit, drill out all 4 rivets that hold the 2 metal airbox attachment clips in the stock airbox.
- 2. Push the 4 rivets outwards from the inside of the airbox & remove both attachment clips, Fig. 1.
- 3. Using the 4 supplied screws, install the new T-brackets snugly, with the Tbracket's flat sides facing outwards, Fig. 2.
- 4. Using a bench-vise or vise-grips, clamp each mounting stud & turn the airbox cover in order to loosen them. Each stud has 2 deep retaining grooves & they're molded into the cover, which makes removal difficult.
- 5. It's optional to use an exacto knife to cut a groove down the side of the stud's plastic mount-grommet in order to open the plastic slightly & extract the stud. Heating the blade makes this easier, Fig. 3.
- 6. To ensure the airbox cover seals tightly against the airbox, also trim approx. 3/8" plastic off the top of the stud's plastic mounting grommet, making it approx. 3/8" shorter, Fig. 4.
- 7. Drill out both stud mounting holes using a 7/32" drill bit. Drill through the airbox cover from the inside out, through the center of both stud mounts, for the new attachment screw holes, Fig. 5.
- 8. Install the new mounting screws & aluminum grommets in the airbox cover. Re-install the airbox cover, checking for proper cover alignment & that all screws are securely tightened.
