Zane Roberts had a 3rd place podium finish and is now 5 points from the Overall leader in the series points lead. Morgan Tanke took home a 3rd place Women's Pro podium after a long day of racing outside her comfort zone. Tanke is currently seated in 4th place for the series points standings only 4 points behind 3rd. Joe Wasson also had a good race finishing in 4th place Overall and is now just two points down away from 3rd place in the series points standings.

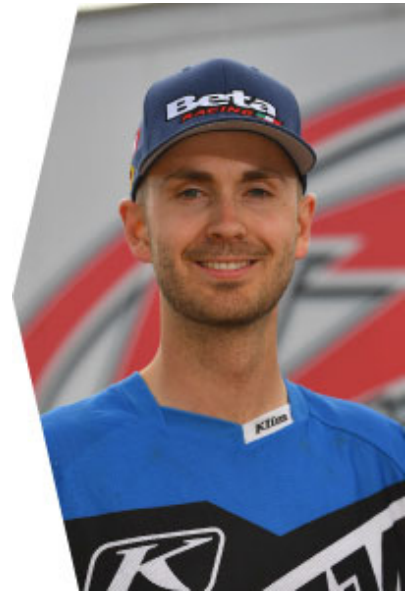

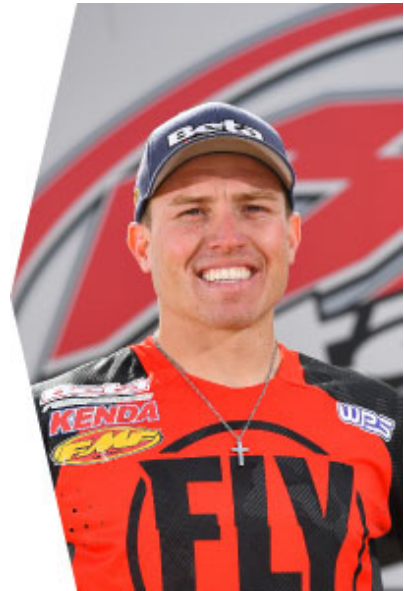
