I had a decent start in the main event and was riding in 5th until I got lost and ended up going the wrong way for about 10 minutes. That cost me a ton of time, but I came in after the first lap and prepped the bike. On the second lap I was riding very conservative to save energy. I got lost one more time for about 10 mins again, but at the end of the lap I caught the 2 places in front of me. The toughest part of the race for me was using the GPS, which is something I've never done before, and the terrain was wild. I learned a ton and got some great confidence on my new Beta. I am really looking forward to the Revlimiter in March."
