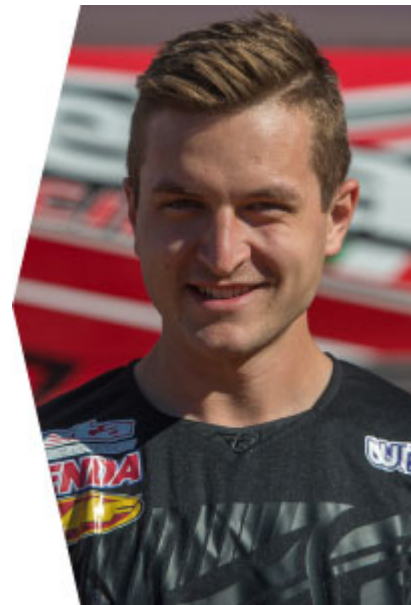

"I got off to a decent start going into the woods in third. I followed first and second for the first lap learning the track. On the second lap I moved into second place and started to challenge for the lead. While going up a hill behind first a rock flung back and hit me right in the nose giving me a swollen, possibly broken, bloody nose. I was able to push through and still run upfront. At the end of the second lap it started raining pretty hard and changed the track completely. After some crashes, and some problems, I dropped to the third place spot. On the last lap I was able to make the pass back for second only to throw it away with a pretty good crash and dropped back to third. My Beta 125 RR was working awesome and worked really well in the slick rocks. I'm frustrated with the mistakes I made. I felt I had the speed to win but some set-backs really cost me.
