National Hare & Hound Round 6 Overview:

Location: Panaca, NV Beta Factory Race Team Results:

- Joe Wasson finished on top of the Pro podium with the overall win and is currently leading the series points standings.
- Beta Support Rider: Zane Roberts took home another Pro 250 class win with a 6th place overall finish. Roberts' currently leads the series points standings with a 40 point lead.
- Morgan Tanke finished on the Women's Pro podium in 2nd place and is currently in 2nd place for the series points standings.


